

## Feast Days in the Tenth Week of Ordinary Time

- **Mon 10 June:** Memorial for **Mary, Mother of the Church.**
- **Tue 11 June:** Memorial for **St Barnabas, apostle.** Born in Cyprus. One of the first converts in Jerusalem, soon after Pentecost. Barnabas went with St Paul on his first missionary journey, and took part in the Council of Jerusalem. Then he returned to Cyprus to preach the gospel, and died there.
- **Thu 13 June:** Memorial for **St Anthony of Padua, priest and doctor of the Church.** Born Lisbon, Portugal, 1195. Entered the Canons Regular of St Augustine, but after ordination, joined the Friars Minor. Exceptional talent as a preacher, and was sent throughout Italy and France to preach against the Catharist heresy. He was the first theologian of the Franciscan Order. He died in 1231.

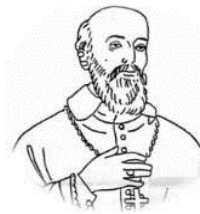

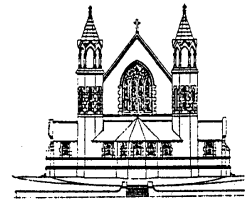

## PENTECOST SUNDAY : 9 JUNE 2019

### From the Parish Pastoral Council

The following is an extract from The Story of Devonport and the Old North Shore 1841-1924.

*In February 1893 a meeting was held in the district school to consider the feasibility of erecting a suitable (Catholic) church at Devonport. The Rev. Fr. Hackett presided. It was announced that as a result of a preliminary canvas for funds, 110 pounds had been raised....In 1917 the church was quite inadequate for the congregation's needs, and a long-discussed project for building a new church was finalised. Messrs T. Mahoney and Son designed the present church which was consecrated by Bishop Cleary in 1919. The cost was 8000 pounds and Messrs Mahoney declared the design to be the best they had ever carried out in New Zealand. It was built over the old church, which was then moved to Takapuna.*

This November, we will celebrate our rich history - the centenary of the consecration of our beautiful church - with a special Mass and a gathering in the Hall afterwards. There is also the Tabernacle project underway, and Alan Light hopes to have funding for that confirmed in time for the replacement Tabernacle (drawing on display at the back of the church) to be finished for the Centennial. However, in the lead-up to the Centennial, we want to gather your memories and stories – you ARE the Parish. Beginning in October, there will be a space for story-telling during each weekend Mass, so as a Council we are asking you to jot down your memories. Don't worry if you feel shy about standing up and telling the story yourself – volunteers will do it for you. The most important thing is to start reminiscing about the events and the parishioners you remember. Please contact me if you would like to help – I can only remember back to 1975!

A big THANK YOU AND CONGRATULATIONS to the Fundraising Committee on the success of the second Hall-eluia Concert last month. It raised over \$4000, which will be used to upgrade the tables and chairs in the Hall, making it a very suitable venue for events and celebrations.

Lastly, a recommendation: Fr Richard Leonard, a Jesuit priest from Sydney, is speaking on Prayer and Mission on July 20<sup>th</sup> 10 am-3pm at St John Vianney Hall, Hillsborough. He is a very engaging, dynamic speaker who is also known for his columns, film reviews and books, including "Where the Hell is God?" #### **PROLIFE FACTS**

At 29 years of age, Abby Johnson was the director of an abortion clinic in Texas. One morning she was unexpectedly asked to assist with an ultrasound-guided abortion. What she saw was "the entire, perfect profile of a 13-week baby" with a "head, both arms, legs and even tiny fingers and toes."

In her book, Unplanned, she tells of then watching as the baby began struggling to turn and twist away from "the probing invader". In that instant Abby knew, "It wasn't just tissue, just cells. It was a human baby, and it was fighting for its life..."

"And then this thought came from deep within me: Never again! Never again!" As a result, Abby left the abortion industry and became an advocate for LIFE.
