- **Tues 13 April:** Optional for **St Martin I, pope & martyr.** Born at Todi in Umbria. Elected Pope in 649; called a Council to condemn the Monothelite heresy, which denied the two natures of Christ. This brought him into conflict with Emperor Constant II who had him exiled and stripped of his honours. He died in the Crimea in 656.

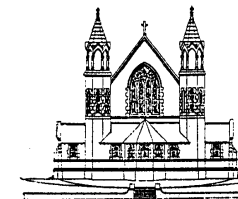
