# 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - 11TH DECEMBER 2022

Today is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday, from the Latin word for *Rejoice*, which opens the entrance antiphon for today. The candle we light is rose coloured, rather than penitential purple - there is a sense of active, joyful waiting.

This is illustrated in today's readings—the blossoming of joy in Isaiah as the Israelites take possession of their own land after years of exile, the patient waiting of the farmer in the letter of James, for his precious crop, and the prefect waiting of John the Baptist, whose whole life was spent in active waiting for the promised Messiah.

Jesus was not the Messiah John expected, not the powerful figure who would overthrow the Romans and establish the Kingdom of God. When asked point-blank by John's disciples if he is the Messiah, Jesus does not give a straightforward yes or no answer, but points to the fruits of his ministry - the blind see, the lame



walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised. We today are invited to "see and hear" the signs of this surprising Jesus. The signs may confound our expectations, but the possibilities of encounter are all around us.

The joy that is such a distinctive feature of the Advent season comes to the fore on this third Sunday. In some parishes this is evident in the presider's rose coloured vestments. It is certainly manifest in the word of God. Isaiah's joyous vision of a new creation is echoed in Jesus' response to the disciples of John the Baptist — "the blind see again, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the Good News is proclaimed to the poor.

# Feast Days in the Third Week of Advent

- Mon 12 Dec: Optional for Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our Lady appeared to the peasant farmer Juan Diego, leaving a miraculous image of herself on his cloak.
- <u>Tue 13 Dec</u>: Memorial for St Lucy, virgin and martyr. Born in Syracuse, she lived her Christianity without concealment, and was martyred during the persecution of Diocletian.
- Wed 14 Dec: Memorial for St John of the Cross, priest and doctor of the Church. Born Spain 1542, became a Carmelite and ordained in 1567. St Teresa of Avila encouraged him to undertake a reform of his Order, but he was opposed and suffered many setbacks. His life of prayer bore fruit in writings that are classics of the mystical life. The Ascent of Mt Carmel, The Dark Night of the Soul, The Spiritual Canticle, The Living Flame of Love.
