Chrism Mass — St Patrick's Cathedral Monday 3rd April, 7.30pm

Each year in Holy Week all the priests of the diocese gather with the bishop to renew their commitment to priestly service. And, it is here

that the sacred oils are blessed and consecrated. These oils are used for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination and Anointing of the Sick.

Members of our parish will attend this Mass to collect these oils. If anyone would like to join in, some of us will be catching the **6.15pm ferry**.
