Feast Days in the Fifteenth Week of Ordinary Time

- Thu 20 Jul: Optional for St Apollinarus, bishop and martyr. Lived in 1st century and
 possibly a disciple of St. Peter. Born in Antioch, Turkey, became the first bishop of Ravenna,
 in Italy. Suffered exile because of his preaching and converts. When Emperor Vespasian
 banished Christians, Apollinaris was beaten by a mob and reputedly died soon after from
 his wounds.
- Fri 21 Jul: Optional for St Lawrence of Brindisi, priest and doctor of the Church. Born at Brindisi 1559, he was a born preacher and entered the Capuchin Order at Verona in 1575. A man of learning who took an active part in Catholic reform; he travelled throughout Europe, preaching, and wrote many works to propound Catholic doctrine. He died in 1619.
- <u>Sat 22 Jul</u>: Memorial for **St Mary Magdalene**. Mark 16:9 tells us that Mary was the first to whom the risen Christ appeared. She was one of his disciples, accompanied him on his journeys through the villages preaching (Luke 8:3), and stood by the cross at Christ's crucifixion.
