

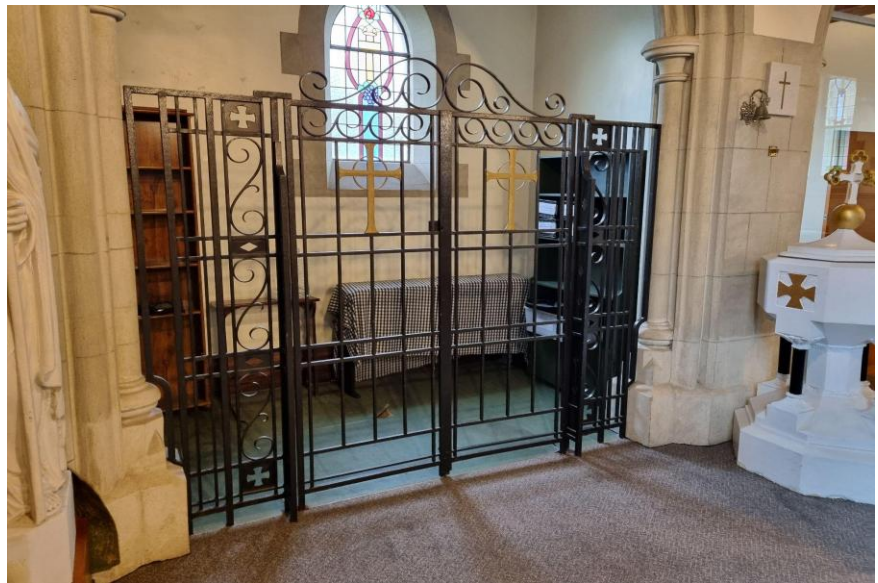
## Week ending 12 September 2025

Mark's great-uncle, Nunzio Arabito, originally from Sicily, created several of the church's beautiful wrought iron features. These include the brackets that hold the hanging lights, the ornate fretwork brackets for the sanctuary lamps, the covering outside that protects the main rose window behind the altar, and the grill and gate at the entrance to the altar servers' room at the back of the church.



It's wonderful to see the family tradition continuing in our church, and we look forward to the installation of the new handrails very soon.
